Selections **4 to beat 3**

Race 2 SPIRIT OF CAMELOT finished a close third in the Nitschke in April after a luckless run. Selections **6 to beat 4**

Race 3 HIGH ON SUGAR we BLACK BOOKED Last start and is down in grade after running second to New York Scandal at Morphetville a fortnight ago. EVEN SHARPER scored at Balaklava in August and has been runner up in two starts since.

Selections **1 -3**

Race 4 is a no bet race for mine ENCIPHERING didn't have the best of luck when placed in town a fortnight ago. Selections **2** if you must have a punt

Race 5 Been waiting for DYER he has had the benefit of a recent trial and wears blinkers for the first time today. **4 to beat 2**

Race 6 JACKS ON ICE had no luck last start and will appreciate a drop in weight with FANCIFY the danger. **8 to beat 4**

Race 7 ZASZOU resumed with a comfortable win. Followed up by rising in class and scoring again. Racing well and rates highly. ANGLAND gets blinkers first time Selections **12 to beat 9**

Race 8 Top weight HOWL is a backmarker who probably would have placed with a clear run in the straight third up. Back in class. THE GOLDEN FIST was too strong for Fine Future at Morphetville Selections **1 from 10**

Race 9 The Cup FAVOURITE CHILD is in good form. She is stepping up to the 1600m, which suits her. Selections: **4-1-9**

Race 10 : MOTORACE is a recent addition to the stables of Micheal Hickmott, who landed some good bets first up and might be hard to be again. Selection **6 to beat 4**
