Boxing Day lived up to expectations with one of the more remarkable starts to a day of Test cricket in living memory. 19 year-old Sam Konstas played one of the most audacious innings on debut to set Australia on their way to 6-311 by Stumps on the opening day. Having faced up first and then played and misses at four of his first six balls, Konstas then reached two of just 20, when he took on the India attack in a way that is usually only seen in white-ball cricket. Call it reckless, stupid or brave – whatever you want, it worked as he peeled off the third fastest 50 by an Aussie on Test match debut.

The kid was unfussed by the whole thing, speaking to FOX Cricket at drinks, then after his dismissal signing autographs and having selfies taking like it was a club game. Whether you like it or not, this is the modern game – hopefully he can back it up the second innings.

Clearly it put the Indians in a flap, Bumrah had his most expensive spell of the series, with Siraj being his usual heated self and Virat Kohli decided that a bump was the best way to sideline Konstas, rather than tell his bowlers to aim at the stumps. The innings helped set the tone for the day and 38 year-old Usman Khawaja played better as a result, as he scored his first 50 for the series. Kohli has been fined for the incident but should have been suspended from the last Test, as again the ICC prove they are as weak as water. Australia passed 100 in the opening session and then in the middle the Indians fought back well to subdue things, before the action-packed last session saw four wickets fall for 135. Marnus Labuschagne and Steve Smith found their rhythm, as did Alex Carey, sadly Travis Head decided to let one go and was bowled for a duck – quite an inexplicable dismissal given how he played in the series.

Australia are well placed, anything past 350 will be a good score. India's are clearly worried about their batting, Rohit is averaging just 11 in his last 13 innings and with Kohli not having made a run since Perth and Pant struggling, they are looking for a big start from Jaiswal and Rahul. With another big crowd expected, it'll be a cracker of a day and ripping rest of the Test.
